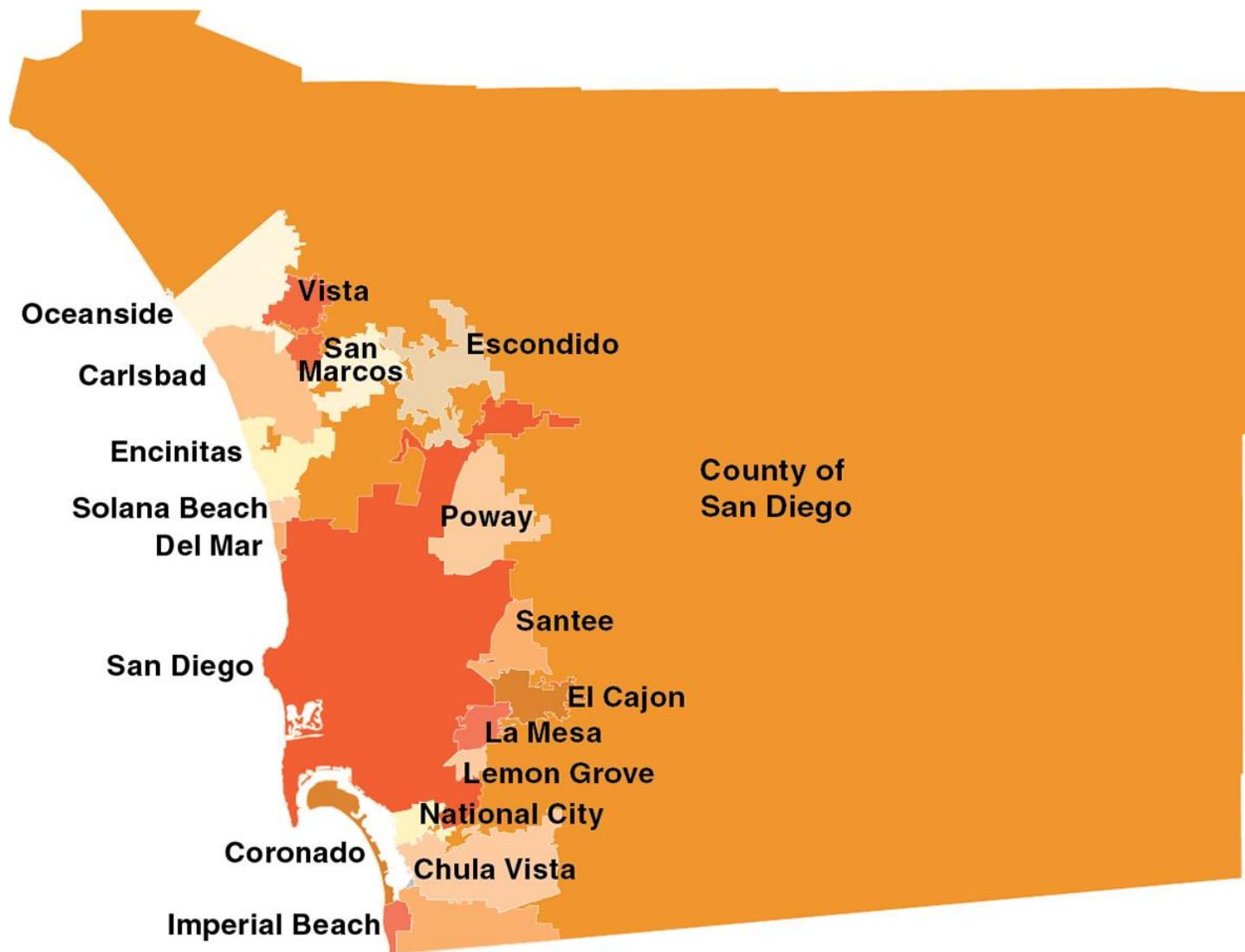

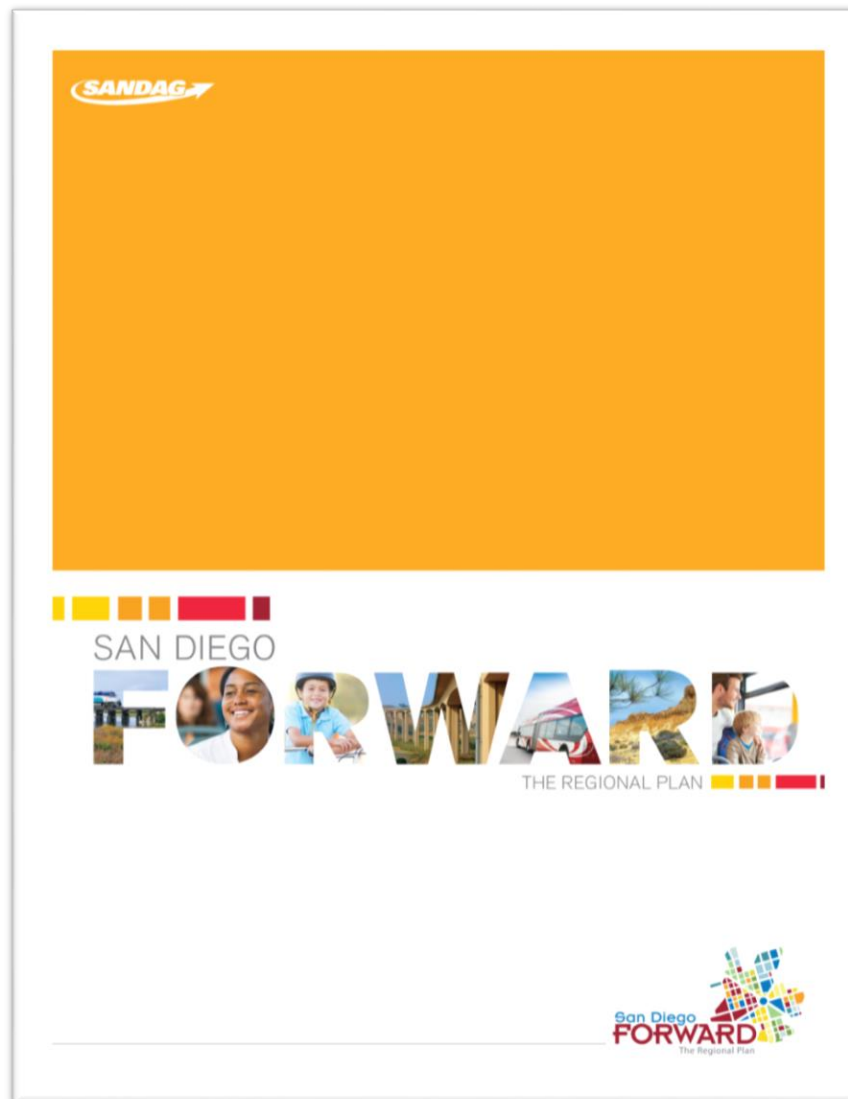

# 2019 Regional Plan Development Process

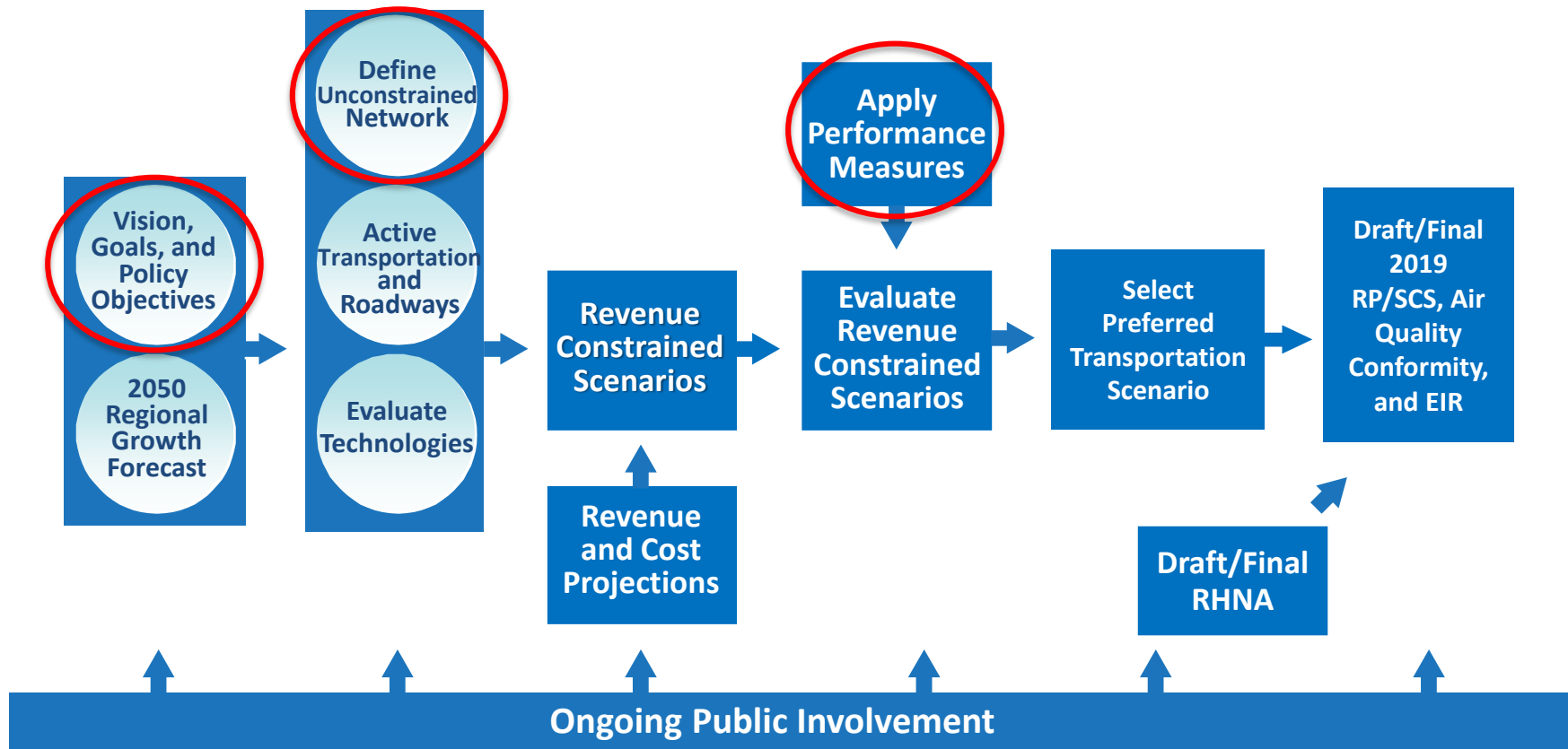

# 2019 Regional Plan Vision and Goals

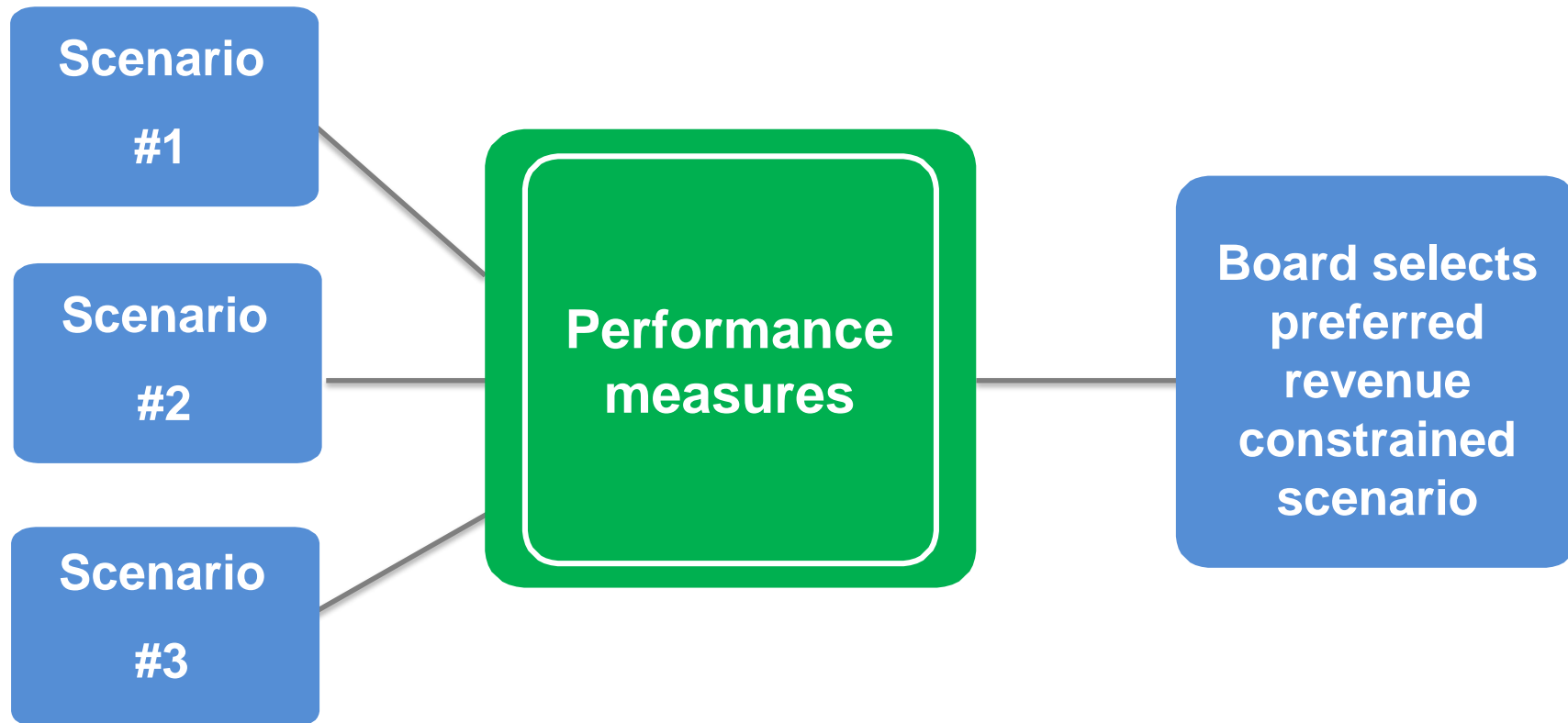


To facilitate the efficient movement of people and goods to support a sustainable and healthy region, a vibrant economy, and an outstanding quality of life for all.
